Dear Iowa State Community:

The Board of Regents today approved Iowa State's tuition rates for the coming year, including a 3.8% increase in base tuition for resident undergraduates (\$284/year), and a 4% increase for nonresident undergraduates (\$852/year). The Board also approved expanding differential tuition to specific programs due to their equipment, lab or increased educational costs. Please refer to the [Office of the Registrar website](#) for additional information about tuition and fees for fall 2018.

In the coming year, we are increasing the amount of university resources directed for student financial aid. Also, scholarship fundraising remains a top priority of the *Forever True, For Iowa State* campaign. More than \$16.5 million was awarded last year in privately-funded scholarships. Iowa State continues to advance excellence in academic, research, and extension programs and critical student services with our other core values of affordability and access.
