Dear Iowa State University Community,

The [Board of Regents just released a statement](#) indicating they have asked all the Regents institutions to move as quickly as possible toward delivering instruction online, as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak.

Iowa State University has been planning and preparing for this contingency with our emergency management leaders and working groups, and **we will share more information very soon.**

The Board of Regents also announced today it will be extending the 30-day international travel ban by 7 days each Monday, effective March 9, until conditions improve. The travel ban initially took effect March 5 and applies to university-sponsored international travel for students, faculty, and staff.
